NOTE:

- 1) On the days when the examination starts at 8am, students are expected to assemble at the parade square by 7.20 am for morning assembly .

- 4) Students are required to report to the examination venue 15mins before the start of each paper.

- 6) In the new Humanities syllabus, there is no Exam for Geography and History for Sec One students.
- 7) Students who do not have any paper for the day are not required to attend school. (Self-Study & No Exam)

- 9) Take note that students must produce a valid MC from a qualified general practitioner failing which he/she will be given a zero mark for the paper/s he/she has missed.
