ELMAB3 ≤ 19	Promotion to Sec 5N(A)	Traineeship	DPP – Higher Nitec	
ELMAB3 = 20 or 21	Retention in Sec 4N(A)	Traineeship	ITE Nitec	
ELMAB3 ≥ 22		Traineeship	ITE Nitec	

* Also obtained Grade 3 or better for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3. Certain PFP courses require an EL grade of 2.

** Also met course-specific entry requirements.

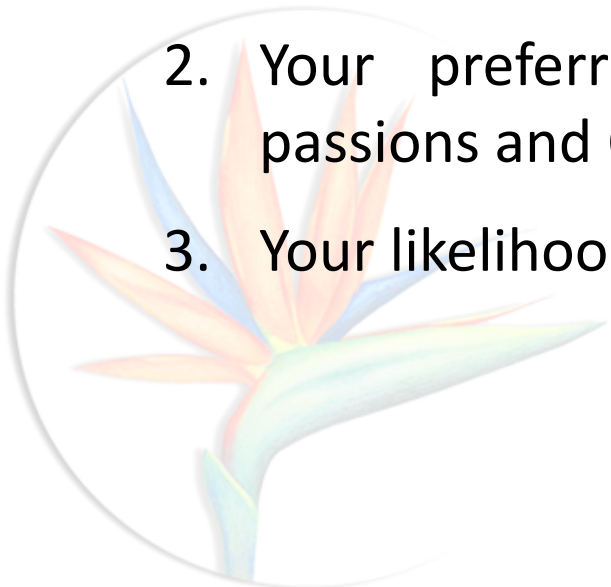

Moving on to Sec 5 and taking the GCE 'O' Level exam

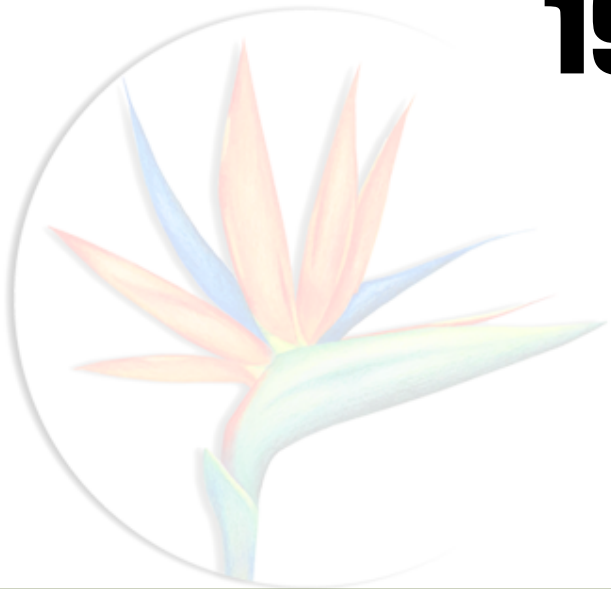
- Students with higher (poorer) ELMAB3 in N Levels tend to also achieve higher (poorer) ELB4 in the O Levels.
- 80% of students who achieved $ELMAB3 \geq 16$ failed to achieve $ELB4 \leq 26$ to qualify for the polys.
- There are exceptions but attitude is key.
- **Make your choices wisely.**

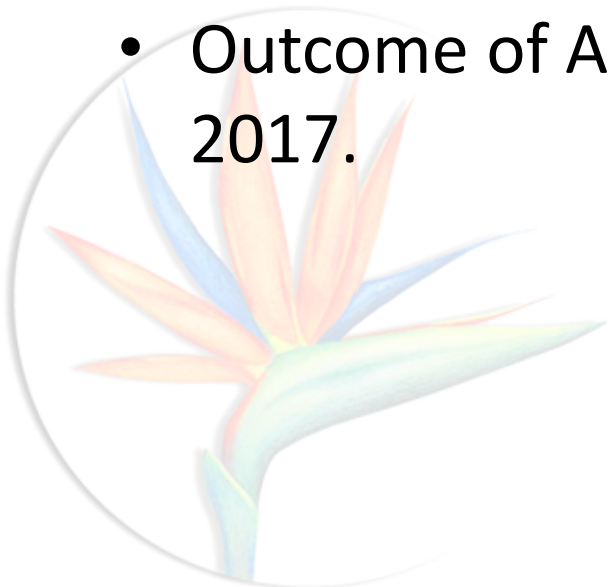
