The House that he/she is assigned to depends on class allocation. The class allocation will be assigned by <u>30</u> **December 2025.**





HMTL

All schools in Singapore have embarked on Full SBB since the 2024 Secondary 1 cohort.

One Secondary Education, Many Subject Bands

With Full SBB, students can take subjects at G1/G2/G3 academic levels, which are mapped from today's N(T)-, N(A)-, and O-Level subjects respectively.




Common learning experiences to build meaningful friendships and appreciate different perspectives

Opportunities to take academic subjects at more demanding level for students

- Your child will be in mixed form classes, i.e., each class will have students admitted via Posting Group (PG) 1, 2 and 3.
- Note that the Posting Group simply guides the **initial** subject levels that your child will take in Secondary 1.
- Students may take subjects at different subject levels at various points in their secondary school journey.



 All students will take the below six common curriculum subjects with their form class mates:



 Your child will proceed to his/her respective subject classes for Mother Tongue, English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities at their respective subject levels (G1, 2 or 3)

Subject Levels under Full SBB

- Students are required to take compulsory subjects at G1, G2 or G3 levels.
- Subject levels for most subjects at the start of Secondary 1 are based on their PSLE Score.

Offering Subjects at More Demanding Levels (MDL)

Sec 1 students admitted through PG 1 and PG 2 may be offered English, Mathematics, Science, and/or, Mother Tongue Languages at more demanding levels, based on their PSLE subject grades.



- Your child/ward can choose to accept or reject the offer of the subject(s) at a more demanding level via PG.
 Please submit your choice by <u>23 December 2025</u>.
- After submission through Parents Gateway (PG), parents and students may proceed with the purchase of textbooks, based on the choice made. Please purchase the learning materials for the corresponding subject level (i.e., G3 or G2 or G1) your child/ward will be studying.
