Participation in school's Learning for Life Programme (LLP)

Students who accept DSA offers through DSA (Sports) must participate in their **respective sports CCAs** for the duration of their secondary school education.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports
Academic, NAPFA and/or CCA records

SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will:

1. go through a **solo** interview to assess applicant's attitude, motivation and leadership qualities, and
2. participate in a Physical test (can be general or related to specific sports) and Skills test (sports specific).

- (C) Marked assignment
Submission of 1 written assignment completed in Primary 6 that has been marked by their primary school teacher

SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through a solo interview where they will:

1. Answer a scenario-based question, and
2. deliver a 1-minute impromptu speech.

and Chinese/Malay)

Participation in school's distinctive Applied Learning Programme (ALP), which includes opportunities for students to showcase talent on various platforms.

Students who accept DSA offers through Bilingualism must participate in either the school's Digital Media Club or English Literary Drama and Debate Society (ELDDS) CCAs for the duration of their secondary school education.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities
- (C) Marked assignment
Submission of 2 written assignments (one in English, one in Chinese/Malay) completed in Primary 6 that have been marked by their primary school teachers

SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through a solo interview where they will:

1. Answer a scenario-based question, and
2. deliver a 1-minute impromptu speech.



WHO CAN APPLY

Students who have some experience in

- writing, or online content creation,
 - photography,
 - video production,
 - audio visual or ICT skills
- for class/CCA/school or, on a platform external to school.

AND/OR

Students who have participated in competitions and/or other opportunities pertaining to digital media

Talents in *Digital Media*

DEVELOPMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Participation in school's Applied Learning Programme (ALP), which includes opportunities for students to showcase their talent in these areas:

- Journalism,
- Digital Media,
- EdTech and/or
- Cyberwellness.

Students who accept DSA offers through Digital Media must participate in either the school's Digital Media Club or English Literary Drama and Debate Society (ELDDS) CCAs for the duration of their secondary school education.

Students will have further opportunities to develop themselves in the CCA.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities
- (C) Submission of relevant artefact(s)
Such as
 - 1 article,
 - 3–5 photographs, or
 - 1 video production, or
 - any relevant portfolio.

SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through a solo interview where they will:

- Share their digital media experience
- Answer scenario-based questions

Applicants who are currently

- CCA Heads / Vice-Heads
- Class Chairpersons / Vice Chairpersons
- Students with other equivalent leadership roles

Talents in *Leadership*

DEVELOPMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Participation in school's distinctive Learning for Life Programme (LLP)

Able to apply for leadership roles within their classes, CCA and also at wider school level

- Class Committee members
- Junior Prefects
- House Captains

Students who accept DSA offers through Leadership must indicate at least one **Uniformed Group** as one of their CCA options.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- (A) School reports
Academic and CCA records
- (B) Records of involvement in relevant activities

SELECTION PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will go through a group situational test, followed by a group interview for those shortlisted from the test.
