For Students Eligible for Subject(s) at More Demanding Level through Full Subject-based Banding (FSBB)

- 1) Check your eligibility.
- 2) If eligible, you and your parents can report to the School Hall on 21 December 2023 (10.30am to 12.30pm) to collect the letter of offer.
- 3) Submit the letter of offer after you make your choices for eligible subject(s) at a more demanding level (e.g., you are in Posting Group 2 and eligible for, and intend to take Science and Mathematics at a more demanding level).
- 4) If you would like to apply for financial assistance, you can proceed to General Office on 21 December 2023.
- 5) Purchase of school uniforms and PE shorts (excluding PE T-shirts)
- 6) Purchase of textbooks from the school bookshop

 Your child/ward will be in mixed form classes, i.e., each class will have students who joined Evergreen Secondary School via Posting Group (PG) 1, 2 and 3.






# Full Subject-Based Banding School



 All students will take six common curriculum subjects with their form class classmates:



 Your child/ward will proceed to his/her respective classes [General (G) 1, 2 or 3] for Mother Tongue, English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities.

### **Subject Levels under Full SBB**



- Students are required to take compulsory subjects at G1, G2 or G3.
- Subject level at the start of Secondary 1 is based on their PSLE Score and indicated by Posting Groups.

PSLE Score	Posting Groups	Indicative level for most subjects at start of Secondary 1
4 – 20	PG3	G3
21 and 22	PG2 or PG3	G2 or G3
23 and 24	PG2	G2
25	PG1 or PG2	G1 or G2
26 – 30 (with AL 7 in EL and MA)	PG1	G1

# Offering Subjects at More Demanding Levels



Sec 1 students in PG 1 and 2 may be offered English,
 Mathematics, Science, and/or, Mother Tongue
 Languages at more demanding level, based on their
 PSLE subject grades.

## **Eligibility Criteria**



Those students in PG 1 and 2 would receive the letter of offer, based on the following criteria shown.

Posting Group	PSLE Standard grade	PSLE Foundation grade	Option to offer subject at
PG2	AL 5 or better	-	G3
PG1	AL 5 or better	-	G2 / G3
	AL 6	AL A	G2

For example, if your child/ward obtains AL 5 for Science in PSLE and is in PG 2, he/she will be offered to take Science at G3 level instead of G2 level in Secondary 1 and 2.



## **Deadline to Submit Letter of Offer**

- Please indicate your decision to accept or reject the offer of the subject(s) at more demanding level in the letter of offer.






**Step 1: Check FSBB/HMT eligibility** 

All students to check for eligibility. You may access the Excel Spreadsheet (via Parents Gateway) to access your eligibility.

- Download Excel Spreadsheet sent via Parents Gateway. Document can only be downloaded and accessed via a desktop or laptop.
- 2. Key in the last 4 digits and alphabet of your child's NRIC on the excel spreadsheet sent through Parents Gateway. For example 4567A from the full NRIC number of "T1234567A".
- 3. If your child is eligible to take subject(s) at more demanding level, please proceed to the school hall today (21 December 2023 from 10.30am to 12.30pm).
- 4. Parking space at the school is limited.




